Forest School

We've had some wonderful bug hunts and the highlight must of course be our rare Marsh fritillary butterfly find. Finally, we've had a good tidy up and reset of the Wild Area, ready for it to rest over the summer. I can't wait to see what next year will bring!

Swimming update

We are pleased to share some exciting updates about our swimming provision for next academic year. From September 2026, we'll be swimming at **Port Regis School**, which will give us access to excellent facilities. Alongside the pool, we'll also have use of their fully equipped gymnasium.

Swimming will continue to be on **Wednesdays**, but we're moving to **afternoon sessions** rather than morning ones. Don't worry about pick-up times – we'll be back at school in plenty of time for normal collection and taxi arrangements.

Swimming is an important part of the National Curriculum, teaching children to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively, and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

The school has previously heavily subsidised the cost of swimming lessons. However, due to rising costs, we're no longer able to subsidise to the same extent as before. As a result, in September swimming charges will increase from **£24 per term to £29 per term**.

We understand that any increase in costs can be challenging for families. If you're concerned about meeting these costs, please don't hesitate to get in touch with the school office in confidence to discuss what support might be available.

In order to allow our new Reception children the time to settle in at school, they will not participate in swimming initially.

We're really looking forward to using these enhanced facilities and know the children will enjoy the new arrangements. If you have any questions about the new swimming provision, please don't hesitate to get in touch with the school office.

School Lunches

We have maintained the price of our school lunches for over ten years, but with ever increasing food and energy prices the time has unfortunately come where we need to review the costs. As a result of that review, the daily cost of hot school lunches will be increasing slightly in September to £2.95 per child.

We hope that you understand this necessary increase, it will allow us to maintain the same standard of high-quality ingredients, meals made from scratch and local shopping wherever possible. This increase does not affect those children who are entitled to free school meals.

Wiltshire Family Hubs Support

Sam Lush, who is the local Family Hub Navigator will be at Tisbury Library on Tuesday 4th August between 10 and 12. Sam will be running a Lego making activity for children, alongside an opportunity for parents to talk to her about support and activities that are happening locally.

The Wiltshire Family Hubs Support service are also running a number of online sessions over the summer holidays, see information below for details:

They still have spaces left on our **TOFP (Time out for Parents) – programmes for July – September 2026**. Virtual sessions are delivered by using MS Teams. (Families will be offered support to join if needed). These are relaxed and non-judgmental workshops where we share tools and strategies for family life, and where parents and carers are encouraged to share their experiences and challenges. We also signpost and share information on other services and offer families 1:1 opportunities to discuss further support needs with our facilitators.

- **Early Years Programme** is for Parents/Carers of children aged 0-5 years
- **Primary Years programme** is for Parents/Carers of children aged 5-11 years
- **Dads Programme** is for Parents/Carers of children aged 3-16 years
- **Children with Additional Needs** is for Parents/Carers of children with additional needs aged 3-12 years, a diagnosis is not required
- **Teens** is for Parents/Carers for children and young people aged 12-18
- **Teens with Additional Needs** is for Parents/Carers of children and young people with additional needs aged 12+ years, a diagnosis is not required
